

2.25.24 Nehemiah 3



Explore - Take time to think through the text/sermon.

Take some time to listen to the sermon before you engage your Missional Community.

- What was the "Big Idea" for this sermon?
- Can you identify the major points from the sermon?
- Was there anything that the Spirit revealed throughout the sermon that you need to further engage?
- Did you find yourself needing to confess anything on the way to communion?

Experience - Try to engage the text in a practical way BEFORE you gather.

There are a few themes that are presented in this text. Let's try to find them.

- What are the ordinary tasks of your daily life? List them out.
- Can you identify any ways that God could use them with greater purpose?
- Spend some time praying and asking God to help you set apart your schedule, just as
 He has set you apart for the work of ministry.

Evaluate - Time to discuss as a community DURING your M.C. gathering.

- Why do you think it is important to understand the difference between Justification and Sanctification?
- When God justifies you He gives you new identity. What are some ways that you have seen God reshape your identity as a Christian?
- The Spirit of God sanctifies you, or keeps you looking like the image of JESUS. What are some tools/gates God has given you to aid in your sanctification?
- Do you believe that you have a new identity?
- What does doubt/disbelief look like in regards to your identity and spiritual disciplines?

Equip - Train Others as you GATHER for when you SCATTER.

Gospel Application

- Take a moment to reflect on the ordinary life of JESUS. What would it have looked like for him to walk the same ground as us. Have fun with it!
- What was so extraordinary about the resurrection of JESUS? How do those truths impact you right now in the everyday ordinary stuff of life?
- How might these truths be good news for the NonBelievers in your life? Is there some good truth you can share right now with someone from your Top 10?
