


3.17.24 Nehemiah 5:14-19



Explore - Take time to think through the text/sermon.

Take some time to listen to the sermon before you engage your Missional Community.

- What was the "Big Idea" for this sermon?
- Can you identify the major points from the sermon?
- Was there anything that the Spirit revealed throughout the sermon that you need to further engage?
- Did you find yourself needing to confess anything on the way to communion?

Experience - Try to engage the text in a practical way BEFORE you gather.

There are a few themes that are presented in this text. Let's try to find them.

Write out how each of the following themes are seen in this passage.

• Overall, the theme of Chapter 5:14-19 is sacrifice. Write out all the ways that Nehemiah models sacrifice.

Evaluate - Time to discuss as a community DURING your M.C. gathering.

- What were the ways Nehemiah modeled leadership differently than the other?
- What are some reasons you abstain from sacrificing for the sake of JESUS?
- What do you believe God is calling you to sacrifice right now?
- As you heard stories of sacrifice from your brothers and sisters on stage what did the Spirit reveal to you?

Equip - Train Others as you GATHER for when you SCATTER.

Gospel Application

- Have you allowed fear to outweigh the sacrifice JESUS is calling you to? How so?
- What truths of the gospel, or what do you know about JESUS, that can bring a calm to your fear? Share them with one another.
- Do you think anyone could have guessed that JESUS death would have lead to such great life? Why do you think you can predict the outcome of your own sacrifice?
- If JESUS had NOT gone to the cross you would not have salvation. How do you think abstaining from sacrifice is hindering your life as well as the life of others?
