


04.07.24 Nehemiah 7



Explore - Take time to think through the text/sermon.

Take some time to listen to the sermon before you engage your Missional Community.

- What was the "Big Idea" for this sermon?
- Can you identify the major points from the sermon?
- Was there anything that the Spirit revealed throughout the sermon that you need to further engage?
- Did you find yourself needing to confess anything on the way to communion?

Experience - Try to engage the text in a practical way BEFORE you gather.

There are a few themes that are presented in this text. Let's try to find them.

Write out how each of the following themes are seen in this passage.

- Where did you see the importance of 'sonship'?
- What are some reasons this book of genealogy matters?
- How might this book point to a different book (I.e. book of life)?
- What are some of the shared inheritances between Israel and the church?

Evaluate - Time to discuss as a community DURING your M.C. gathering.

- Take time to read Ephesians 1:3-6
- What is true about your calling to sonship as seen in Ephesians?
- What does it mean to be 'holy and blameless'?

Equip - Train Others as you GATHER for when you SCATTER.

Gospel Application

- If the previous is true, what is now the shared inheritance between JESUS and the church?
- How does life begin to change for you/others hearing that God chose you from before the foundation of the world?
- What are some areas of sin that you can let go of as you respond to your calling to 'Sonship'?
- How does the gospel help you respond to your inheritance and let go of your past?
- Why might these truths be important to share with people who are not yet Christian?
